

How to make NATIONAL RIDE2SCHOOL DAY 2019

Obstacle course

Set up bike obstacle courses or activities on basketball courts so students can get full use of their wheels before school starts.



Breakfast

Host a healthy breakfast.

Bike parking

Organise 'overflow' bike parking if your school doesn't have bike parking facilities.



Decorate your bike

Host a 'decorate your bike' or 'decorate your helmet' competition. Students could parade their creations at assembly.

Bike tour

Take students for a bike ride around your local area - don't forget to involve other teachers and parents.



Bike checks

Organise bike maintenance checks/workshops for students - your local bike shop may volunteer a staff member.

Bike education

Integrate riding into the curriculum (check out the Ride2School Day resources on our website for curriculum materials).

School raffle

Hand out raffle tickets to the walkers and wheelers as they arrive at school and present a prize (or a few) at the assembly.

Guest speakers

Arrange an assembly with a special guest speaker/s (e.g. Member of Parliament, local police officers or local riding super-stars)



Bike safety

Organise for a local police officer to talk to students about bike safety. While they are there, ask them to engrave student bikes.



Fund raising

Take the opportunity to raise funds. Ask for a gold coin donation. The proceeds can go towards improving the bike parking facilities at your school.
