Providing verbal encouragement and morale support is instrumental to your role and your enthusiastic approach really adds to the supportive and fun environment of this event. You are also there to help them with basic mechanical support.

On event duties:

- Riding safely along the route (20km and 50km)
- Assisting riders with basic mechanical support, if required
- Communicating with SAG wagon drivers and informing of mechanical problems or physical conditions which may hinder the rider completing the event and helping riders get their bike on the SAG wagon trailers if required.
