WHAT YOU'LL GET UP TO

As part of the Volunteer Operations team you will be helping to ensure that all volunteer equipment makes it from point A to point B each day as we move from campsite to campsite. You will also be setting it all up and packing it all down each day – adding to the volunteer experience by providing all volunteers with their housing for the event and setting up the volunteer support area where they go to relax during their down time.

On a daily basis you will be:

- Setting up and packing down volunteer tents and overseeing their allocation to volunteers
- Setting up tables, marquees and other equipment for the volunteer support area and coordinating the logistics involved with getting it from campsite to campsite
- Coordinating vehicle movements and drivers each day
- Assisting the Volunteer Support team in distributing volunteer uniforms on the first day
- Ensuring that all volunteers get their lunches each day, by transporting them to the Volunteer Support Area
