



## Ride2School Grants Term 3 2019

### Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is: the Ride2School Program; which is affiliated with Bicycle Network and the Victorian State Government whose registered office is at Level 4, 246 Bourke Street. Melbourne, Victoria. 3000.
2. Employees of Bicycle Network or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the competition or helping to set up the competition shall not be permitted to enter.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter Ride2School grants.
4. Entry is only open to Victorian schools registered in the Ride2School Program.
  - 4.1 'Enter' is defined as teaching staff or the Ride2School contact that has opted in to register their school for the program.
  - 4.2 Entry to grants is via the Ride2School website.
  - 4.3 School must be registered with the Ride2School Program prior to entering.
  - 4.4 School must also complete all questions in the application survey.
5. Entry to the Ride2School grants are open as of **9am Monday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2019**.
6. Closing time and date for the Ride2School grants is at **5pm Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019**.
7. Submissions entered past specified time (**5pm Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019**) will not be valid.
8. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the grants will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.

Commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Is the school registered online with Bicycle Network's Ride2School program?</i></li><li>• <i>Has the school submitted at least four HandsUp! counts during the year and demonstrated an ongoing commitment to being engaged in the Ride2School program?</i></li></ul>
Need	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Does the application identify a specific need and give details about how the grant will address this need?</i></li><li>• <i>Will the grant help more students ride and actively travel to school?</i></li></ul>
Quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Is the application complete?</i></li><li>• <i>Has the school answered all mandatory questions in the application?</i></li><li>• <i>Have all details and information been supplied to Ride2School to support the application?</i></li></ul>

10.3 The Ride2School team will decide the grant amount based on the school's application, the maximum value of one individual school grant will be **no greater than \$5,000**.

10.4 The winning schools will be announced and notified from **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2019**.

11. The winning schools will be notified by email and/or phone within **7 days** of the announcement date. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within **14 days** of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.

11.1 In addition to being contacted directly, the winners will also be announced on the Ride2School Facebook page ([facebook.com.au/Ride2School](https://facebook.com.au/Ride2School)).

12. The Ride2School Program work with the winners to decide how the grant can be collected or how it will be awarded.
