### WHAT YOU'LL GET UP TO

As part of the Campsite team you will be ensuring the Great Vic community have a safe place to camp for the night. You'll be setting up a site that's easy to get around and a joy to camp on. In the mornings you also be helping the team to pack down equipment quickly to move forward and set up the next. You will be following site plans and working as a team to get the job done. You may be required to work split shifts and undertake a variety of tasks, so flexibility and adaptability is a must!

On a daily basis you will be:

- Installing and removing signage and equipment including bunting, flags and star pickets
- Painting lines to show walking paths and camping zones
- Following pre-planned campsite maps to locate equipment
- Packing down equipment and sites in preparation for the move to our next site

**Dates:** Saturday 27 November – Sunday 5 December 2021

**Reporting to:** Campsite Team Leader

**Indicative shift times:** Most days, you'll be required from approximately 6am – 1pm. Some days, you'll have a split shift, where you'll work from 6am – 11am, take a break and then come back to help pack up from 3pm. Please note these times are a guide only and may vary from day to day.

**Work location:** On campsites, outside in all weather conditions
