### WHAT YOU'LL GET UP TO

As part of the logistics team you will be helping to ensure all vehicles and the stuff in them get to where they need to go and get there safely! In the mornings, you will be either manning the vehicle gate and directing traffic at the forward site or helping to ensure rider luggage gets tightly packed on the truck. In the afternoons, you could be manning the gate, or assisting in grouping unpacked luggage in front of signage.

On a daily basis you will be:

- Working with the campsite team to direct vehicles and riders on campsite
- Ensuring vehicles get to their correct place, either on site or in the vehicle parking zone
- Directing the loading and unloading of luggage trucks
- Installing and packing up signage and flags
- Grouping left luggage to minimise misplacement
- Assisting to search for misplaced luggage
