THE BIG PICTURE

Bicycle Network is a not-for-profit out to solve the problem of physical inactivity: two-thirds of Australian's don't get enough exercise. So, we're on a mission to make bike riding easier for everyone. The Great Victorian Bike Ride is a fun, friendly and challenging camping holiday where people can enjoy time on the bike with likeminded people. For volunteers, it's the opportunity to spend a week in another world, joining our canvas community to help pull off an extraordinary event all while exploring the beautiful Victorian countryside.

WHAT YOU'LL GET UP TO

As part of the SAG team you will be working in teams of two driving along the rider route and keeping an eye out for any riders having troubles. If a rider is unable to continue riding for the day, you'll be getting their bike on the trailer and driving them and the bike back to campsite. You will have a plan to follow for where you should be located throughout the day, but it may change as different weather conditions and environments affect the riders.

On a daily basis you will be:

- Driving a 12 or 22-seater bus with a trailer attached
- Driving safely along the rider route and transporting riders
- Helping riders to get their bike on the trailer
- Maintaining regular contact with Event Assistance
- Documenting and recording which riders are using SAG vehicles

- Are you confident driving around riders and understand the Victorian road rules?
